### **Grants Available: Lexington Area Community Foundation Now Accepting Applications from Nonprofits**

**LEXINGTON, N.C.** – The Lexington Area Community Foundation is currently accepting applications for its 2025 grant program. Eligible applicants include 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations, congregations, governmental and educational institutions. Please note that for-profit businesses are not eligible for funding.

Grants will be awarded in support of a broad range of charitable purposes. Priority will be given to effective programs and projects that address a community need and will prioritize requests that focus on: arts and culture, education (including early childhood school readiness), human services, and workforce development. All proposed projects or programs must serve residents of Davidson County.

The Foundation will award grants up to \$5,000 to eligible organizations. However, actual award amounts will be determined based on merit of the project/program and available funds. The board may consider a grant up to \$10,000 for a new and innovative project.

To begin the application process, visit [fftcgrants.communityforce.com](https://fftcgrants.communityforce.com) and select “Lexington Area Community Foundation” to access the online application. Returning applicant organizations can log in to the Online Grants Center using their previously established ID and password. First-time applicant organizations can create a new account.

**Completed applications must be submitted by NOON on Friday, Aug. 22, 2025.** The online grant application closes promptly at 12:00 p.m. and will not accept late submissions.
